TEACHERS—TAKE NOTE

- Artwork should be brought to Carnegie Hall during the week of February 1-4, 2011 between 9am -5pm.
- Schools from outlying areas of the county may use the school mail van to transport artwork to the Board of Education Office.
- All work accepted for the exhibit must remain on display for the duration of the show.
- Any art work not collected by April 5th will be returned to the school by mail van.

REQUIREMENTS

- All artwork must be matted before the artwork is brought to Carnegie Hall
- Artwork must be titled
- Only one entry per student
- Student's name should appear only on the back of the artwork
- Artwork should be submitted only with student's permission

Please use the following formula to determine the maximum number of entries from your school:

Total enrollment of 300 or less.....10 entries
Total enrollment 301-499.....13 entries
Total enrollment of more than 500.....15 entries
Home School Network & private schools...5 entries

JUDGING

Student artwork will be judged by a panel of three judges selected by Carnegie Hall. The judging will be divided by category and grade. The categories are:

- Mixed media
- Drawing
- Water color
- Painting: Oil or Acrylic
- Pastel
- Photography

Grades 4-5, 6-8 and 9-12 will be judged separately. Best of Show—The overall winner will be awarded a \$50 Savings Bond. Best in elementary, middle and high school divisions will also be recognized.
